
As the serenity and solace of a merciful death freed Him from the sorrows of mortality, He returned to the presence of His father. At the

last moment, the Master could have turned back. But He did not. He passed beneath all things that He might save all things.


His lifeless body body was hurriedly but gently placed in a borrowed tomb.

On the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and other faithful women set out for the tomb to further anoint the body of Jesus. They saw the angel, and were afraid;


but he said unto them: 'Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here: for he is risen...
